

Rules for the Dump Truck

You **cannot** put these items in the dump truck:

- **Household trash**
- **Asbestos materials**
- **Paint**
- **Refrigerants**
- **Batteries**
- **Extra heavy items such as concrete blocks or chunks**
(If you have to use a front end loader to load the truck the material is too heavy.)
- **Tires**

You **can** put these items in the dump truck:

- **Refrigerators (Freon has to be drained and refrigerator has to be tagged by a licensed person.)**
- **Building materials**
- **Glass**
- **Roofing material**
- **Lumber**
- **Limbs**
- **Dirt**

***Do not over fill. Items should not be higher than the truck side rails or hanging out of the back of the truck. Leave the tailgate as-is (down).**

***Customers using the truck cannot pay someone else to do the work for them. If you are the person being paid to do the work you may not use the dump truck.**

Violation of these rules or over-filling the truck will result in loss of privileges to use the dump truck.
